The Global Health Flexible Residency track facilitates meaningful global neurology educational opportunities for residents interested in developing tools for a successful and productive career in global health. The flexible residency provides residents with up to 6 months of protected time for an in-depth global health experience combining hands-on, in-country training with a formal global health curriculum. Residents can cultivate skills in diverse areas of global health, including capacity building, neurology training and education, research, and clinical care.

As part of a Global Health flexible residency experience, residents will be able to leverage the wealth of resources available through the UCSF global health community, including the UCSF Institute for Global Health Sciences <sup>[1]</sup>. Although traditional research need not be a primary aim of this pathway, residents will be expected to develop a scholarly project as part of their 6-month experience.
